Dennis Dusseau, Dock Chairman, would like to reword part of the Dock Usage By Laws policy After much discussion it was suggested that:

Article #4 which is worded:

Each dock will be numbered by stakes, placed along the shoreline. These stakes will be placed approximately 30 feet apart long both the South and North shorelines.

The new wording would read:

Each dock will be numbered by pins, placed along the shoreline. These pins will be placed approximately 28 1/2 feet on the south side and 30 feet on the north side.

Joe Lumatta made a motion to accept this change and Jan Muck seconded this motion.

Article #5 which is worded: When installing docks, please use pin positions both on shore and the white PVC pipe markers in the lake at the end of your dock.

The new wording would read:

When installing docks, please use pin positions both on shore and the white PVC pipe in the water. Center the dock on both points.

Brian Byars made a motion to accept this change and Barry Alderman seconded this motion.

To complete these changes, a second vote must be taken at our next meeting.

Discussion on trees on property from our recent storm was discussed.

Also Dennis said all dock requests were filled.

New Business The issue on Washington Street was discussed. Lee answered many question .The cost to repair this situation will be approximately \$2000.00. Float stone and gravel will be used. Many questions were asked and it comes down to the fact that this is wet lands and the county will not do any more. We have a contract with no expiration date to complete our suggested work. We hope to get this attended to next spring. Lee offered to bring up his heavy machinery and will reinvestigate all rules and regulations before we start this project. At this point Barry Alderman made a motion to go forth with this project and it was seconded by John Wilheimi. All members were in favor.

Tony Danilowicz motioned to close this meeting and it was seconded by Pam Scott.
